A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOL LAND TRANSFER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the
- 2 contrary, the fee simple interest to land identified by tax map
- 3 key (4)3-6-002:010 (Wilcox elementary school) with the existing
- 4 improvements thereon shall be conveyed by the department of
- 5 education to the county of Kauai as grantee, as is.
- 6 (b) The department of education shall prepare, execute,
- 7 and record, in the land court or bureau of conveyances, as
- 8 appropriate, a quitclaim deed to convey the property identified
- 9 in subsection (a) with all existing improvements to the county
- 10 of Kauai as grantee. As this is a conveyance in which the
- 11 county of Kauai and the State and its agencies are the only
- 12 parties, the tax imposed by section 247-1, Hawaii Revised
- 13 Statutes, shall not apply.
- 14 (c) The county of Kauai shall accept the property in its
- 15 existing condition. All claims and liabilities against the
- 16 department of education, if any, which the county of Kauai has,
- 17 may have had, or may have in the future, regarding any injury,



- 1 loss, cost, damage, or liability, including reasonable
- 2 attorney's fees, concerning the physical, environmental, soil,
- 3 economic, and legal conditions of the conveyed property, shall
- 4 be released, waived, and extinguished.
- 5 (d) Work to initiate the conveyance of the property shall
- 6 commence no later than December 31, 2024.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- **8** revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to
- 10 the department of education to prepare, execute, and record the
- 11 quitclaim deed required by this Act.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 15 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 17 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
- 18 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 19 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
- 20 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
- 21 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further

- 1 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total
- 2 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
- 3 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 4 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- **5** \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
- 6 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 7 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- 8 serve the public interest; and
- 9 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- 10 addressed by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
