

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the rising cost of
- 2 insurance contributes substantially toward the soaring costs of
- 3 housing in Hawaii. Section 657-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 4 requires developers or improvers of real property to insure
- 5 against deficiencies of such improvements for ten years. The
- 6 insurance costs for this ten-year period are being passed on to
- 7 the purchasers of that real property, significantly driving up
- 8 costs.
- 9 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to limit to six years
- 10 the period of time to commence an action to recover damages
- 11 based on construction to improve real property.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 657-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) No action to recover damages for any injury to
- 15 property, real or personal, or for bodily injury or wrongful
- 16 death, arising out of any deficiency or neglect in the planning,
- 17 design, construction, supervision, and administering of

- 1 construction, and observation of construction relating to an
- 2 improvement to real property shall be commenced more than two
- 3 years after the cause of action has accrued, but in any event
- 4 not more than [ten] six years after the date of completion of
- 5 the improvement."
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 8 begun before its effective date.
- 9 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
