A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part III, subpart C, to be		
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§302A- Nationally certified school psychologist;		
5	incentive program. (a) There is established within the		
6	department a nationally certified school psychologist incentive		
7	program to recognize and support exemplary educational practice		
8	by offering incentive payments to school psychologists who earn		
9	the Nationally Certified School Psychologist Credential from the		
10	National Association of School Psychologists. The nationally		
11	certified school psychologist incentive program shall provide:		
12	(1) A \$5,000 bonus per year to each nationally certified		
13	school psychologist who maintains a current national		
14	<pre>certification;</pre>		
15	(2) Up to \$500, depending on the certification fee		
16	structure, upon completing all components of the		
17	Nationally Certified School Psychologist credential;		

1	(3)	A reimbursement of the remainder of the national	
2		certification application fee upon achievement of the	
3		Nationally Certified School Psychologist credential;	
4		and	
5	(4)	An additional \$5,000 bonus per year to each school	
6		psychologist employed by the department who maintains	
7		a current Nationally Certified School Psychologist	
8		certification and provides school psychology services	
9		to children in a hard-to-fill area as defined by the	
10		department.	
11	(b)	The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91	
12	necessary	to carry out the purposes of this section."	
13	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
14	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so	
15	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to		
16	offer incentive pay for the nationally certified school		
17	psychologist incentive program established pursuant to section		
18	of this Act.		
19	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of	
20	education	for the purposes of this Act.	

1 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 2 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 4 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state 5 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 6 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the 7 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund 8 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further 9 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total 10 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these 11 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling 12 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by 13 per cent. The reasons for exceeding the 14 general fund expenditure ceiling are that: 15 The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to (1)16 serve the public interest; and 17 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs 18 addressed by this Act. 19 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
