A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTION INTEGRITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that signature 2 verification is necessary to protect against voter fraud and ensure election integrity. The purpose of this Act is to ensure 3 4 that signature verification is implemented in election 5 procedures. 6 SECTION 2. Section 16-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended to read as follows: 8 "\$16-45 Official observers. Official observers shall be 9 designated by the chief election officer or the clerk in county 10 elections to be present at the counting centers and ballot 11 envelope signature verification facilities and selected in the 12 following manner: 13 (1) No less than one official observer designated by each 14 political party; No less than one official observer from the news 15 (2)

media;

1	(3) Additional official observers as space and facilities
2	permit designated by the chief election officer in
3	state elections and the clerk in county elections.
4	The chief election officer or clerk shall give all official
5	observers reasonable notice of the time and place where the
6	ballots shall be counted and ballot envelope signatures shall be
7	verified. No person shall be permitted in the counting center
8	and ballot envelope signature verification facilities without
9	the written authorization of the chief election officer or
10	clerk."
11	SECTION 3. Chapter 16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
12	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
13	read as follows:
14	"§16- Signature verification of ballot envelopes.
15	Signature verification personnel, to be designated by the chief
16	election officer or the clerk in county elections, shall perform
17	all duties related to ballot envelope signature verification in
18	the presence of at least two official observers."
19	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
20	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
