A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORLD PEACE DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that World Peace Day,
- 2 also officially known as the International Day of Peace, is a
- 3 United Nations-sanctioned holiday observed around the world on
- 4 September 21. Originally established in 1981 by the United
- 5 Nations General Assembly, the holiday is dedicated to world
- 6 peace through observing twenty-four hours of non-violence and
- 7 cease-fire.
- 8 The legislature further finds that as international
- 9 conflict continues in certain parts of the world, the
- 10 recognition of world peace and aspiration toward world peace
- 11 become more important and significant.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to designate September 21 of
- 13 each year as World Peace Day.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 15 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 16 read as follows:

1 "§8- World Peace Day. September 21 of each year shall
2 be known and designated as "World Peace Day". This day is not
3 and shall not be construed to be a state holiday."
4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
