A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that following the Maui 2 wildfires in August 2023, the speaker of the state house of 3 representatives established six bipartisan interim working 4 groups tasked with evaluating specific topics in the aftermath 5 of the wildfires and making recommendations for appropriate 6 legislative action in the regular session of 2024. Members of 7 the working groups collaborated with federal, state, and county 8 agencies, along with community stakeholders and interested 9 parties, to identify immediate issues that require temporary or 10 transitional relief for the people and businesses of west Maui. 11 The legislature further finds that the jobs and business 12 working group was specifically tasked with evaluating the Maui unemployment rate, approaches to restart business activity, and 13 impacts to tourism statewide and preparing recommendations for 14 appropriate legislative action. All working groups released a 15 16 joint final report in December 2023 detailing their findings and

17 recommendations.

The purpose of this Act is to adopt the recommendation of
 the jobs and business working group by funding adjunct faculty
 positions at the university of Hawaii Maui college to train
 persons in construction trades.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025
for full-time equivalent (FTE) temporary adjunct
faculty positions at the university of Hawaii Maui college to
train persons in construction trades.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of 12 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 14 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 16 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state 17 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 18 exceeded by \$ per cent. In addition, the or 19 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund 20 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further 21 exceeded by \$ or per cent. 2	two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
