A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STANDARDS OF CONDUCT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:
3	"(g) In addition to the disclosures required under
4	subsection (f), each member of the legislature shall also
5	disclose the name of any person that is subject to section 97-3
6	and that is:
7	(1) A business partner of the member;
8	(2) An employer of the member;
9	(3) An officer or \underline{a} director of the member's employer; or
10	(4) A client of the member, member's partner, or member's
11	employer, [who is on the lobbyist list and not just a
12	client with a lobbyist, where] where the member knows,
13	or reasonably should know, that the client provided at
14	least \$5,000 of income during the preceding calendar
15	year.
16	As used in this subsection:
17	"Member" means a member of the legislature.

- 1 "Member's partner" means a member's spouse under
- 2 chapter 572, civil union partner under chapter 572B, or
- 3 reciprocal beneficiary under chapter 572C."
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 3000.
