A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the 2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2024. 3 SECTION 2. Act 70, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, is amended as follows: 4 5 1. By amending part II to read: 6 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS 7 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated 8 9 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of 10 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium 11 beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025. The total 12 expenditures and the number of permanent and temporary positions established in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not 13 14 exceed the sums and the position ceilings indicated for each 15 year, except as provided in this Act.

The reasons 3 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the 4 appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve the 5 public interest and to meet the needs provided for by this Act. 6 SECTION 5. If any portion of this Act or its application 7 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any 8 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall 9 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is 10 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall 11 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to 12 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the 13 extent possible. 14

SECTION 6. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular session.

19 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
