- 5 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 6 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 7 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
- 8 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
- 9 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The
- 10 reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are
- 11 that the appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve
- 12 the public interest and to meet the needs provided for by this
- 13 Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,500,000 or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to carry
- 17 out the purposes of this Act.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
