A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOBILE VACCINATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that vaccines are a
- 2 critical intervention that dramatically decreases the health
- 3 impacts of influenza, coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19),
- 4 respiratory syncytial virus, and other viruses that affect the
- 5 general population. Studies have demonstrated the tremendous
- 6 importance of vaccines in both reducing the severity of illness
- 7 as well as the transmission of disease. During the COVID-19
- 8 pandemic, federal funding from the Federal Emergency Management
- 9 Agency allowed for the deployment of mobile vaccination units to
- 10 populations who had limited access to health care facilities or
- 11 pharmacies providing the vaccine and who were unable to be
- 12 transported to vaccination centers. These mobile vaccination
- 13 units were highly successful in increasing vaccination rates and
- 14 reducing the spread of COVID-19 and influenza during the
- 15 pandemic.
- 16 The legislature further finds that to reduce the burden on
- 17 hospitals and medical facilities, the State should continue to

- 1 support community vaccination efforts, particularly for
- vulnerable populations with reduced access to vaccines.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 4 department of health for mobile vaccination services for
- 5 populations with reduced access to vaccines.
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 8 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 9 mobile vaccination services for populations with reduced access
- 10 to vaccines.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 14 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 16 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
- 17 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 18 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
- 19 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
- 20 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further
- 21 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total

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- 1 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
- 2 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 3 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 4 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
- 5 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 6 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- 7 serve the public interest; and
- **8** (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- 9 addressed by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
