## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature has received complaints that 2 the residents living in the Pacific Palisades area of Oahu are 3 unable to hear the emergency siren located at Pearl City high 4 school, and the emergency siren at Palisades elementary school 5 has been inoperative for several years. The legislature finds that a new emergency siren is needed in the area so that 6 residents can be alerted to all civil defense emergencies in a 7 timely manner in order to take any necessary safety measures. 8 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 10 installation of a new outdoor emergency siren in the Pacific 11 Palisades area of Oahu. 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 13 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 14 15 the installation of a new outdoor emergency siren in the Pacific
