### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to 3 read as follows: 4 ""Historic property" means any building, structure, object, district, area, or site, including a heiau and an underwater 5 site, [which] that is over [fifty]: 6 (1) Fifty years old [-] and meets the criteria to be placed 7 8 onto the Hawaii register of historic places or has 9 important value to Native Hawaiians or other ethnic 10 groups of the State due to associations with cultural 11 practices once carried out, or still being carried 12 out, at the property or due to associations with 13 traditional beliefs, events, or oral accounts that are 14 important to the group's history, traditional practices, and cultural identity; or 15 16 (2) One hundred years old."
