In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 13 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 15 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state 16 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 17 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the 18 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund 19 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further 20 exceeded by \$ per cent. The combined total or 21 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
