BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 334-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$334-4 Personnel for mental health program. The director
- 4 shall appoint professional and nonprofessional staff as the
- 5 director deems necessary to carry out the state mental health
- 6 program and for which appropriations are available. Positions
- 7 for psychiatrists and psychologists are exempted from chapter
- **8** 76. The director may employ psychiatrists and psychologists as
- 9 needed by the department on a contractual basis, subject to the
- 10 approval of the governor. The director may appoint an
- 11 administrator, three associate administrators, a director of
- 12 psychosocial rehabilitation, a chief of the department of
- 13 nursing, a risk manager, a patients' rights advisor, and a
- 14 facilities plant engineer for the state hospital or a secure
- 15 psychiatric rehabilitation facility established pursuant to this
- 16 chapter and these positions shall be exempt from chapter 76."
