If], minus administrative costs as determined by 9 10 the office of administrative hearings of the department of 11 commerce and consumer affairs; provided that full forfeiture of 12 the cash or protest bond shall occur if the initiating party 13 does not prevail in the administrative proceeding $[\tau]$ and the 14 office of administrative hearings finds that the appeal was 15 frivolous or made in bad faith, in which case the cash or 16 protest bond shall be deposited into the general fund."
