## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding	a new section to part XIII, subpart E to be
3	appropria	tely designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§</u> 11	- Solicitations relating to disasters. (a) No
5	candidate	, candidate committee, or noncandidate committee shall
6	solicit a	contribution in a manner that would lead a reasonable
7	person to	believe that the solicited contribution would
8	primarily be used to provide assistance to persons directly	
9	affected	by a disaster unless the solicitation includes an
10	explicit	disclosure that:
11	(1)	The solicited contributions are subject to state
12		campaign finance law;
13	(2)	Contributions may be used to influence the outcomes of
14		elections for political office or votes relating to
15		ballot questions; and
16	(3)	Persons affected by the disaster may not necessarily
17		benefit from any solicited contribution.

- 1 (b) The disclosure described in subsection (a) shall be
- 2 prominently displayed or announced in a manner that a reasonable
- 3 person is likely to notice while reading, listening to, or
- 4 observing the remainder of the solicitation.
- 5 (c) A person who violates this section shall be guilty of
- 6 a class C felony.
- 7 (d) For the purposes of this section, "disaster" shall
- 8 have the same meaning as in section 127A-2."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
