RELATING TO THE RESIDENTIAL LANDLORD-TENANT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 521, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately

 designated and to read as follows:

 "§521- Changing of locks; required. Upon entering into
- 5 a rental agreement with a tenant for a period of six months or
- 6 longer for any residential property, the landlord shall change
- 7 or rekey all locks to the property before the tenant's date of
- 8 initial occupancy; provided that the landlord shall be granted a
- 9 grace period of not more than thirty days after the tenant's
- 10 date of initial occupancy to comply with this section."
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 13 begun before its effective date.
- 14 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
