
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL LITTERING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-829, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows:

3 "(4) The court shall sentence any person convicted of
4 committing the offense of criminal littering as follows:

5 (a) For the first offense, the person shall spend four
6 hours of either picking up litter on public property
7 or performing community service;

8 (b) For any subsequent offense, the person shall spend
9 eight hours of either picking up litter on public
10 property or performing community service; and

11 (c) The court shall fine the person convicted of
12 committing the offense of criminal littering [~~at least~~
13 ~~\$500, but not more than~~] \$1,000."

14 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16 begun before its effective date.
