9	(2) Ensure the continued prohibition on the use or		
10	application of pesticides containing chlorpyrifos		
11	pursuant to section 149A-31(7); and		
12	(3) Inform the public of the most recent pesticide		
13	inspection results for agricultural producers.		
14	(b) In establishing the pesticide inspection program, the		
15	department shall:		
16	(1) Develop a system to conduct inspections annually or ir		
17	response to a complaint on the premises of an

1		agricultural producer to determine if any violations
2		of section 149A-31(3), (4), or (7) were committed; and
3	(2)	Develop an online reporting tool for restricted use
4		pesticides, with the data available to the public.
5	(c)	The department shall post the results of all pesticide
6	inspectio	ns conducted pursuant to this section on the
7	departmen	t's website and update the results upon completion of
8	each insp	ection.
9	(d)	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
10	91 necess	ary for the implementation of this section.
11	(e)	As used in this section, "agricultural producer" means
12	a farmer,	cooperative association, or landowner who derives its
13	gross inc	ome from agricultural activities conducted within the
14	State."
