A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AIRPORT VISITORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many individuals
- 2 without airline boarding passes wish to accompany traveling
- 3 friends and family members to airline gates, which are beyond
- 4 airports' security checkpoints. The legislature recognizes that
- 5 federal law grants states flexibility in establishing programs
- 6 to authorize these visits.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 8 transportation to establish and implement at Daniel K. Inouye
- 9 International Airport a non-traveler visitor pass program.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 261, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 12 and to read as follows:
- 13 "<u>\$261-</u> Non-traveler visitor pass program. (a) The
- 14 department shall establish and implement at Daniel K. Inouye
- 15 International Airport a non-traveler visitor pass program for
- 16 individuals without airline boarding passes. Each passholder

1	may visit	the airport beyond the federal Transportation Security
2	Administr	ation checkpoints for the purpose of:
3	(1)	Accompanying another person who has an airline
4		boarding pass to or from an airline gate, or from an
5		airline gate to the baggage claim area or ground

7	(2)	Engaging in any other lawful activity authorized by
8		the department.
9	(b)	The department shall coordinate with the federal
10	Transport	ation Security Administration and other appropriate
11	governmen	tal agencies in creating and managing the program.
12	(c)	The department may impose:
13	(1)	Limitations on the number of non-traveler visitor
14		passes that may be issued on any day;
15	(2)	Limitations on the amount of time that a non-traveler
16		visitor may remain beyond a federal Transportation
17		Security Administration checkpoint; and
18	(3)	Other limitations intended to ensure airport security.
19	(d)	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to
20	chapter 9	1 necessary for the purposes of this section."
