A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELLISON ONIZUKA SPACE CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation shall
- 2 identify appropriate land under the department's jurisdiction to
- 3 re-establish and operate the Ellison Onizuka Space Center
- 4 museum.
- 5 (b) The department of transportation shall coordinate the
- 6 redevelopment with the Onizuka family and Onizuka Memorial
- 7 Committee.
- 8 (c) The department may enter into contracts for the
- 9 museum's design and construction, subject to chapter 103D,
- 10 Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 11 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
- 12 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 13 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 14 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
- 15 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
- 16 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The reasons
- 17 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the



- 1 appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public
- 2 interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the
- 6 department of transportation to re-establish and operate the
- 7 Ellison S. Onizuka Space Center.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
