
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ELLISON ONIZUKA SPACE CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of transportation shall
2 identify appropriate land under the department's jurisdiction to
3 re-establish and operate the Ellison Onizuka Space Center
4 museum.

5 (b) The department of transportation shall coordinate the
6 redevelopment with the Onizuka family and Onizuka Memorial
7 Committee.

8 (c) The department may enter into contracts for the
9 museum's design and construction, subject to chapter 103D,
10 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

11 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
12 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
13 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
14 that the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
15 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
16 to be exceeded by \$, or per cent. The reasons
17 for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the



1 appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public
2 interest and to meet the need provided for by this Act.

3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the
6 department of transportation to re-establish and operate the
7 Ellison S. Onizuka Space Center.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
9 transportation for the purposes of this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
