A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of human services shall
- 2 develop a safe parking program allowing unsheltered persons who
- 3 sleep in their vehicles to park on state lands overnight.
- 4 (b) The office of planning and sustainable development
- 5 shall identify state lands that are suitable for the program.
- 6 (c) The department of human services and office of
- 7 wellness and resilience shall coordinate with homeless service
- 8 providers to determine how needed services, including access to
- 9 showers, laundry facilities, and medical assessments, can be
- 10 provided to program participants on a mobile basis.
- 11 (d) The department of human services shall submit a report
- 12 of its findings and recommendations, including a detailed plan
- 13 for the safe parking program and any proposed legislation,
- 14 including recommended amendments to section 291C-112, Hawaii
- 15 Revised Statutes, regarding prohibited uses of parked vehicles
- 16 on public property between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.,

- 1 to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
- 2 convening of the regular session of 2025.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 6 the planning and development of the safe parking program.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 10 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 11 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 12 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
- 13 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 14 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
- 15 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
- 16 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further
- 17 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total
- 18 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
- 19 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 20 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by

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1 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
2 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
3 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
4 serve the public interest; and
5 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
6 addressed by this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
