A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under existing law,
- 2 only an authorized solicitor or a representative of a
- 3 manufacturer or wholesale dealer of liquor is authorized to
- 4 represent their products in other counties of the State. This
- 5 puts other licensees, particularly small local producers like
- 6 independent wineries, brewpubs, and small craft producer pubs,
- 7 at a disadvantage, as these smaller licensees are only allowed
- 8 to promote within the county where their liquor license has been
- 9 issued. The legislature believes that those holding a winery,
- 10 brewpub, or small craft producer pub license should be provided
- 11 with the same opportunity to grow their brands within the State
- 12 as is already afforded to those with a manufacturer or wholesale
- 13 dealer license.
- 14 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to allow persons to
- 15 apply for a permit to act as solicitors or representatives of
- 16 wineries, brewpubs, and small craft producer pubs in any county
- 17 of the State.

3	"(c) Any person desiring to act as the authorized
4	solicitor or representative of a manufacturer [or], wholesale
5	dealer, winery, brewpub, or small craft producer pub in any
6	county shall make application to the commission of [such] the
7	county in which the person proposes to act for a permit [to act
8	as such]."
9	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
