BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the hazard mitigation special fund for the Hawaii emergency management 2 3 agency of the department of defense, pursuant to a recommendation made by the auditor in auditor's report no. 4 5 23-16, and to transfer any unencumbered balance of the hazard mitigation special fund to the general fund. 6 7 SECTION 2. Section 127A-18.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 repealed. 9 ["[\$127A-18.5] Hazard mitigation special fund. (a) There 10 is established in the state treasury the hazard mitigation 11 special fund, into which shall be deposited: 12 (1) All revenues from any recovery or reimbursement 13 pursuant to section 127A 18; 14 (2) Appropriations made by the legislature for deposit 15 into the fund; 16 (3) All contributions from public or private partners; and

1	(4) All interest earned on or accrued to moneys deposited
2	in the special fund.
3	(b) Moneys in the hazard mitigation special fund shall be
4	used for personnel costs and operating and administrative costs
5	deemed necessary by the agency to administer section 127A-18."]
6	SECTION 3. Any unencumbered balance in the hazard
7	mitigation special fund shall lapse to the credit of the general
8	fund.
9	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
