16	(3)	The state foundation on culture and the arts trust
17		account, administratively established in 1984;

1 (4)The temporary deposits -- automotive management trust 2 account, administratively established in 1996; and 3 (5) The temporary deposits--public works trust account, 4 administratively established in 1988. 5 SECTION 3. The legislature determines that there are amounts in excess of the requirements of various non-general 7 funds. The director of finance is authorized to transfer or abolish the following funds or amounts or so much thereof as may 8 9 be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 from the following funds 10 to the general fund: 11 (1); and 12 (2) SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000. 13
