A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII EDUCATOR LOANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii educator 2 loan program was established to recruit college students to 3 become educators and ensure that these graduates teach in the 4 State's public schools. The program provides loans to students 5 who agree to teach in hard-to-fill positions at public schools 6 or at public schools located in rural areas. Loan recipients 7 who successfully complete their teaching education program and go on to teach in a position that meets the requirements of the 8 9 program are eligible for forgiveness of the loan.

10 The legislature further finds that the State continues to 11 face a growing shortage of qualified teachers. The legislature 12 believes that increasing the amount of funds available to issue 13 loans under the Hawaii educator loan program will help to 14 encourage more students to teach in hard-to-fill positions 15 within the department of education, including those at rural 16 schools.



1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the 2 Hawaii educator loan program. 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be deposited into the Hawaii educator loan program revolving fund. 6 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii 8 educator loan program revolving fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 to 9 10 be used for the Hawaii educator loan program. 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of 12 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act. 13 SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 14 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the 16 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state 17 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 18 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the 19 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund 20 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further 21 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total
