A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 261, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2022 (Act 261), established the workforce
- 3 readiness program to provide opportunities for high school
- 4 students and adult education students to earn associate degrees,
- 5 workforce development diplomas, and other certificates to ensure
- 6 they develop skills and credentials needed to make them highly
- 7 employable. Since the enactment of Act 261, McKinley community
- 8 school for adults has been making great strides in successfully
- 9 implementing the workforce preparation program for adults and
- 10 high school students. However, adult education teachers for
- 11 workforce preparation programs, such as the career foundations
- 12 certificate program, are part-time temporary hires, which are
- 13 often difficult to fill and maintain. The legislature believes
- 14 that providing funding for full-time equivalent teachers will
- 15 further the success of workforce preparation programs.
- 16 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 17 funds for four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) career foundations



- 1 certificate program teachers for McKinley community school for
- 2 adults.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 6 four full-time equivalent (4.0 FTE) career foundations
- 7 certificate program teachers for McKinley community school for
- 8 adults.
- 9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 10 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 12 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 13 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 14 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
- 15 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
- 16 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
- 17 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
- 18 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further
- 19 exceeded by \$380,000 or per cent. The combined total
- 20 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
- 21 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling

for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by

or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the

general fund expenditure ceiling are that:

(1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to serve the public interest; and

(2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs addressed by this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
