A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:
4	"CHAPTER
5	AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS IN STATE BUILDINGS
6	§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:
7	"Automated external defibrillator" means a portable
8	electronic device, approved by the United States Food and Drug
9	Administration, that is capable of diagnosing cardiac arrythmias
10	and uses defibrillation to reestablish an effective cardiac
11	rhythm.
12	"Department" means the department of accounting and general
13	services.
14	"State building" means any building or portion thereof that
15	is owned or leased by the State and is occupied by state
16	employees.

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1 S -2 Requirement to install and maintain automated 2 external defibrillators in state buildings. (a) No later than January 1, 2025, the department shall install in every state 3 4 building: 5 (1) At least one automated external defibrillator placed on each floor, accessible to employees of the state 6 7 agencies listed in section -4 and the public 8 visiting those agencies' facilities; and 9 (2) Appropriate signage posted to indicate the location of 10 each automated external defibrillator. 11 (b) The department shall notify emergency services 12 providers, as defined under section 78-52, of the existence, 13 location, and type of each automated external defibrillator 14 installed in a state building. 15 (C) This section shall not apply to state buildings where 16 the lease agreement specifically prohibits automated external 17 defibrillators. 18 S -3 Administering agency. The department shall 19 administer the provisions of this chapter and adopt rules, 20 exempt from chapter 91, necessary to carry out the purposes of

21 this chapter.

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1	§ -4 Training. (a) The department shall provide		
2	training on the use of automated external defibrillators for all		
3	of its employees and the employees and security staff of the:		
4	(1) Office of the governor;		
5	(2) Office of the lieutenant governor;		
6	(3) State legislature;		
7	(4) Department of education;		
8	(5) Department of law enforcement; and		
9	(6) Department of corrections and rehabilitation,		
10	in accordance with the standards of the American Heart		
11	Association, the American National Red Cross, or any similar		
12	certificate-issuing organization.		
13	(b) The department may contract for or procure as		
14	necessary the services of another public or private entity to		
15	assist with the training required under this section.		
16	(c) Each state agency listed in subsection (a) shall		
17	provide to the department the names and electronic mail		
18	addresses of those state employees required to take the		
19	applicable training and shall assist the department by providing		
20	adequate meeting facilities, equipment, and technical support as		
21	needed for the training.		

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\$ -5 Maintenance. The department shall conduct periodic
 inspections of all automated external defibrillators to ensure
 that they are maintained in an operative condition and are
 replaced or repaired when defective in accordance with the
 operation and maintenance guidelines established by the
 manufacturer.

7 § -6 Exception to liability. Any person who administers
8 an automated external defibrillator installed or maintained
9 pursuant to this chapter shall be subject to section 663-1.5(e),
10 and the protections provided thereunder."

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the installation and maintenance of automated external defibrillators in state buildings pursuant to this Act.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 17 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act. 18 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 20 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for 21 the department of accounting and general services to provide

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training on the use of automated external defibrillators in
 state buildings pursuant to this Act.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of4 accounting and general services for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93, 6 7 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state 8 9 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be 10 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the 11 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund 12 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further 13 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total 14 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these 15 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling 16 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by

17 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the 18 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:

19 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to20 serve the public interest; and

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1	(2)	'he appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
2		ddressed by this Act.

3 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
