A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MAUNA KEA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 195H-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:		
3	"(b) Beginning after the transition period has expired,		
4	any lease executed by the authority for an astronomical		
5	observatory shall include reserved viewing or observing time of		
6	not less than seven per cent of the total amount of viewing or		
7	observing time provided by the astronomical observatory for the		
8	University of Hawaii, as negotiated by the authority $[\cdot]_{i}$		
9	provided that reserved viewing or observing time shall not be		
10	accepted in lieu of rent. The university shall give priority on		
11	the use of the reserved viewing or observing time to projects		
12	that include the participation of:		
13	(1) Hawaii students, including:		
14	(A) Graduate and undergraduate students of the		
15	University of Hawaii;		
16	(B) Students of Hawaii public schools operated by the		
17	department of education; and		

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1		(C) Students from any other school, public or
2		private, in which education is provided to
3		students in the medium of the Hawaiian language,
4		in whole or in part, or that includes a Hawaiian
5		language proficiency requirement for graduation;
6		and
7	(2)	Projects curated and submitted by the University of
8		Hawaii at Hilo Imiloa astronomy center."
9	SECT	ION 2. Section 195H-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to	o read as follows:
11	"[[]:	3195H-12[]] Lease provisions; generally. Each lease
12	issued by	the authority shall contain the following provisions:
13	(1)	The specific use or uses to which the land is to be
14		employed;
15	(2)	The improvements required; provided that a minimum
16		reasonable time be allowed for the completion of the
17		improvements;
18	(3)	Restrictions against alienation;
19	(4)	The rent, as established by independent appraisal or
20		rules of the authority, or both, or at public auction,
21		which shall be payable not more than one year in

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1 advance, in monthly, quarterly, semiannual, or annual 2 payments; provided that rent shall be commensurate 3 with rents charged for similar astronomical 4 observatories globally; 5 (5) Where applicable, adequate protection of forests, 6 watershed areas, game management areas, wildlife 7 sanctuaries, and public hunting areas, reservation of 8 rights-of-way and access to other public lands, public 9 hunting areas, game management areas, or public 10 beaches, and prevention of nuisance and waste; 11 (6) If the lease is for an astronomical observatory, 12 reserved viewing or observing time in accordance with 13 section 195H-8(b); and 14 (7)Other terms and conditions as the authority deems 15 advisable to more nearly effectuate the purposes of 16 the Hawaii State Constitution and of this chapter." 17 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 18 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 19 begun before its effective date. 20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

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1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
