## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 206M-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The development corporation may provide grants to any business in Hawaii that: 5 Receives a federal small business innovation research (1)phase I or II award or contract from any participating federal agency, up to fifty per cent of the amount of 7 the federal award or contract: Receives a federal small business technology transfer 9 (2) 10 program award or contract from any participating 11 federal agency, up to fifty per cent of the amount of 12 the federal award or contract; 13 Receives a federal small business innovation research (3) 14 phase III or small business technology transfer 15 program phase III award or contract, up to fifty per

cent of the amount of the award or contract funded by

Adds purchasing of renewable energy technology systems as an eligible expense, and clarifies that training on new and existing manufacturing equipment is an eligible expense, for the Manufacturing Development Grant Program.
