- 10 assist state and county agencies on projects within and outside
- 11 of designated community development districts upon request.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 206E-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §206E-18[+] Assistance by and to state and county
- 15 agencies. Any state or county agency may render services to,
- 16 assist, and enter into cooperative agreements with the authority
- 17 upon request of the authority [-] for purposes of this chapter.
- 18 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this chapter, upon

DEPARTMENT:

Business, Economic Development, and Tourism

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

PURPOSE:

To clarify that upon request, the Hawaii Community Development Authority (the Authority) may render services to and assist state and county agencies with projects within and outside of designated community development districts.

MEANS:

Amend section 206E-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Authority is the State's redevelopment agency, responsible for community renewal by promoting and coordinating public and private sector development. The legislature establishes community development districts, in which the Authority oversees development.

As the needs of the State evolve, the Authority would like to utilize its experience and knowledge in master planning communities, infrastructure development and improvement, and project management to assist other state and county agencies on projects within and outside of designated community development districts.

Impact on the public: Depending on the type of assistance provided by the Authority, including assistance with public safety facilities, infrastructure improvements, and affordable housing development, this bill could significantly benefit the public and improve conditions for the residents of the State of Hawaii.
