A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 206E-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 2 allows state or county agencies to render services to the Hawaii
- 3 community development authority upon request.
- 4 The Hawaii community development authority wishes to
- 5 utilize its cumulative experience and knowledge to assist other
- 6 state and county agencies.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to amend section
- 8 206E-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to clarify that the Hawaii
- 9 community development authority may provide services to and
- 10 assist state and county agencies on projects within and outside
- 11 designated community development districts upon request.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 206E-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- "[+]\$206E-18[+] Assistance by and to state and county
- 15 agencies. Any state or county agency may render services to,
- 16 assist, and enter into cooperative agreements with the authority
- 17 upon request of the authority [-] for purposes of this chapter.

- 1 Notwithstanding any law in this chapter to the contrary, upon
- 2 request of a state or county agency, the authority may render
- 3 services to, assist, and enter into cooperative agreements with
- 4 state or county agencies for projects within and outside
- 5 designated community development districts."
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
