A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

15	SECTION 11. Notwithstan	ding any provision o	f this Act,
16	with the approval of the gove	rnor, the director o	f finance may
17	transfer unrequired balances	from the appropriate	d funds as may
18	be available between parts I and III of this Act as necessary.		as necessary.
19	SECTION 12. Funds appro	priated or authorize	d by this Act
20	that are not expended or encur	mbered by June 30, 2	025, shall

lapse as of those dates.

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1	SECTION 13. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
2	the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
3	Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
4	appropriations contained in H.B. No. 40, S.D. 1, C.D. 1, will
5	cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year
6	2024-2025 to be exceeded by \$323,123,869 or 3 per cent. In
7	addition, the appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
8	general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
9	further exceeded by \$363,685,821 or 3.3 per cent. The reasons
10	for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
1	(1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
12	serve the public interest; and
13	(2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
l 4	addressed by this Act.

SECTION 14. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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Report Title:

Public Employment Cost Items; BU-2, BU-3, BU-4, BU-9, BU-13, and BU-14; Emergency Appropriations; Expenditure Ceiling

Description:

Makes emergency appropriations for collective bargaining cost items for the members of Bargaining Units (2), (3), (4), (8), (9), (13), and (14) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal biennium 2023-2025. Makes emergency appropriations for the public employment cost items and cost adjustments for employees of the Senate, House of Representatives, and various legislative agencies who are excluded from collective bargaining.
