
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST
ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I

2 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
3 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
4 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

6 SECTION 2. There are appropriated from the sources of
7 funding indicated below to collective bargaining statewide (BUF
8 102) the following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary
9 to fund for fiscal biennium 2023-2025 all collective bargaining
10 cost items in the agreement negotiated with the exclusive
11 representative of collective bargaining units (2), (3), (4),
12 (9), (13), and (14):

9 as may be necessary to fund for fiscal biennium 2023-2025 the
10 salary increases and other cost adjustments authorized by
11 chapter 89C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for state officers and
12 employees who are excluded from collective bargaining, assigned
13 to the Hawaii health systems corporation, and belong to the same
14 compensation plans as those officers and employees within
15 bargaining units (2), (3), (4), (9), and (13):

18 SECTION 13. Funds appropriated by this part shall be
19 allotted by the director of finance to the Hawaii health systems
20 corporation for expenditure in the respective fiscal year for
21 the purposes of this part.

2 SECTION 14. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
3 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
4 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
5 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
6 from the respective funds.

7 SECTION 15. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
8 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2024, and
9 June 30, 2025, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
10 those dates.

11 SECTION 16. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
12 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
13 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
14 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-
15 2024 has already been exceeded by \$1,005,342,735 or 9.4 per
16 cent. The appropriations contained in this Act will cause the
17 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024
18 to be further exceeded by \$ or per cent. This
19 declaration takes into account the additional general fund
20 appropriations authorized for fiscal year 2023-2024 in this Act



1 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
2 ceiling are that:

- 3 (1) The appropriations made in this Act are necessary to
4 serve the public interest; and
5 (2) The appropriations made in this Act meet the needs
6 addressed by this Act.

7 SECTION 17. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
