# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 279, Session
- 2 Laws of Hawaii 2022 (Act 279), appropriated out of the general
- 3 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$600,000,000 or so
- 4 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 to
- 5 provide a multi-pronged approach to reducing the over
- 6 twenty-eight thousand applicants on the department of Hawaiian
- 7 home lands waitlist.
- 8 The legislature further finds that Act 279 stipulated that
- 9 any moneys not encumbered for specific purposes shall lapse to
- 10 the general fund on June 30, 2025. Article VII, section 11 of
- 11 the State Constitution provides that no appropriation shall be
- 12 for a period exceeding three years. This provision therefore
- 13 permits the encumbrance of biennial appropriations one year
- 14 beyond the biennial period, so no later than June 30, 2024, for
- 15 the fiscal biennium 2021-2023. Accordingly, unencumbered funds
- 16 appropriated by Act 279 will lapse on June 30, 2024.

## H.B. NO. 2420 H.D.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to make a new appropriation of
- 2 general funds for fiscal year 2024-2025 to make up for any Act
- 3 279 funds that lapse on June 30, 2024, in order to give
- 4 practical effect to the legislature's intent for the
- 5 appropriation in Act 279.
- 6 SECTION 2. Act 279, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is
- 7 amended by amending section 6 to read as follows:
- 8 "SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$600,000,000 or so
- 10 much there of as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 for
- 11 the purposes of this Act; provided that any moneys not expended
- 12 or encumbered for specific purposes shall lapse to the general
- 13 fund on June 30,  $[\frac{2025}{}]$  2024.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act."
- 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 18 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of Act 279, Session Laws of
- 21 Hawaii 2022.

# H.B. NO. 2420 H.D. 1

- 1 SECTION 4. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 2 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held
- 3 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 4 applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
- 5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 6 of this Act are severable.
- 7 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 3000.
