A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 5 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 6 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 7 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-
- 8 2024 has already been exceeded by \$1,005,342,735 or 9.4 per
- 9 cent. The appropriation contained in this Act will cause the
- 10 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024
- 11 to be further exceeded by \$ or per cent. This
- 12 declaration considers the additional general fund appropriations
- 13 authorized for fiscal year 2023-2024 in this Act only. The
- 14 reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are
- **15** that:
- 16 (1) The appropriations made in this Act are necessary to
- serve the public interest; and

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- (2) The appropriations made in this Act meet the needs
 addressed by this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. The legislature finds that several instances of
- 4 asbestos disturbance have been reported at the department of
- 5 health's main offices at Kinau Hale, located at 1250 Punchbowl
- 6 Street, Honolulu, Oahu. Ambient air sampling by a private
- 7 environmental and industrial health and safety vendor throughout
- $oldsymbol{8}$ the building found that any fibers in the air are at a level
- 9 below the minimum detection level. These minimum detection
- 10 levels are lower than the U.S. Occupational Safety and Health
- 11 Administration's actionable threshold of 0.1 fibers/cc, as well
- 12 as the more stringent industry standard for clearance level of
- 13 0.01 fibers/cc.
- 14 Although testing confirms that the air in Kinau Hale is
- 15 safe, these incidents are occurring more often, and the
- 16 building's overall condition is poor and has been steadily
- 17 deteriorating. A major incident, such as heavy rains causing
- 18 massive roof leaks, could turn the building into a localized
- 19 public health emergency.
- The legislature further finds that Kinau Hale's location on
- 21 a large parcel adjacent to private medical facilities would make

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- 1 it suitable for mixed-use redevelopment, including the
- 2 department's offices and private clinical facilities in a
- 3 public-private partnership.
- 4 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to make an emergency
- 5 appropriation to the department of health for emergency asbestos
- ${f 6}$ remediation and temporary relocation of the main offices of the
- 7 department of health, if necessary, and preliminary planning for
- 8 redevelopment of the site.
- 9 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for
- 12 emergency asbestos remediation; moving costs and other expenses
- 13 associated with temporarily relocating the department of
- 14 health's offices at 1250 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Oahu, if
- 15 necessary; and preliminary planning for redevelopment of the
- 16 site.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 health for the purposes of the Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
