### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding to part III a new section to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§103D-</u> Alternative procurements. (a) A procuring
5	agency may select an alternative procurement method when the

8	demonstration project, or by federal approval of the alternative

10	(b) The head of a purchasing agency shall determine in

### Report Title:

Methods of Source Selection; Alternative Procurement; and Government Services

### Description:

Amends section 103D-301, HRS, methods of source selection, to add the alternative procurement method. Amends chapter 103D, HRS, to add to part III a new section allowing an alternative procurement method when the federal government provides for or approves the alternative procurement method, and the head of the purchasing agency makes a written determination that it is neither practicable nor advantageous to use the existing statutory procurement methods.

#### JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT:

Transportation

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

PURPOSE:

To add the alternative procurement method as a source selection for contract formation, but the alternative procurement method may be used only after the head of the purchasing agency determines in writing that it is neither practicable nor advantageous to the State to use any of the methods of procurement in section 103D-302, 103D-303, 103D-304, 103D-305, 103D-306, or 103D-307, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

Furthermore, the alternative procurement method shall be used only when federal statute, federal regulation, or federal special experimental or demonstration project guidance, or other similar federal procurement guidance allows for the use of the alternative procurement method.

MEANS:

Add a new section to part III of chapter 103D, HRS, and amend section 103D-301, HRS.

JUSTIFICATION:

Provide measures for improving contracting practices and promoting quality and innovation in goods and services and construction that have the potential to reduce the life cycle cost of such projects, while at the same time, maintain product quality to provide some degree of administrative flexibility.

Alternative methods provide options for unique, complex, or schedule-critical projects. An agency that uses an alternative method is afforded flexibility in evaluating proposals and in contract negotiations, which can result in substantial cost savings and other substantial benefits to the State.

Impact on the public: This bill promotes an innovative procurement method and a new project delivery system within the intent of the Procurement Code's competition requirements. An alternative procurement method will allow for timely improvements delivered to the community at a guaranteed price without added costs from change orders.

Impact on the department and other agencies:
This bill will allow purchasing agencies to
use an innovative procurement method,
providing a process improvement to the state
procurement requirements. The potential for
project awards to be based on best value
with limited change orders during contract
administration may be realized.
