## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

8	(1) Section 103D-302 (Competitive sealed bids);
9	(2) Section 103D-303 (Competitive sealed proposals);

12	(5) Section 103D-306 (Sole source procurement); [and]
