# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII RESIDENT TUITION FEE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that facilitating
- 2 postsecondary education and training for all interested high
- 3 school graduates is a matter of statewide concern.
- 4 Postsecondary options assist graduates by preparing them for
- 5 jobs and career pathways that typically pay higher wages, which
- 6 enables them to achieve their educational and career goals and
- 7 afford the State's high cost of living. Increased enrollment
- 8 and completion of postsecondary education and training will
- 9 enhance the State's human capital.
- 10 The university of Hawaii amended its administrative rules
- 11 to streamline the enrollment process for all applicants for
- 12 admission into the university of Hawaii system; however, the
- 13 current statutory requirements regarding residency for tuition
- 14 purposes pose challenges for some local graduating high school
- 15 seniors or recent graduates. Specifically, some students
- 16 experiencing homelessness have difficulty providing evidence of
- 17 bona fide residency as required by statute, and students who

- 1 have complex family situations may be incorrectly considered
- 2 nonresidents. The legislature further finds that recognizing
- 3 local high school graduates as residents to qualify for resident
- 4 tuition fees would facilitate the enrollment of these students
- 5 at one of the university of Hawaii's campuses.
- 6 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to simplify the
- 7 residency determination for the State's high school graduates to
- 8 enroll in postsecondary education and training at the university
- 9 of Hawaii by considering graduates of the State's high schools
- 10 to be residents for tuition purposes.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 304A-402, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- "[+]\$304A-402[+] Residence for tuition purposes; basic
- 14 rule. The board of regents shall adopt the necessary rules
- 15 defining residence for tuition purposes herein; provided that
- 16 the basic rule shall be that a student shall qualify for the
- 17 resident tuition fee only if the following criteria are met:
- 18 (1) The adult student, or in the case of a minor student,
- the student's parents or guardians, has or have been a
- 20 bona fide resident of this State for at least twelve
- 21 consecutive months [next] immediately preceding the

1		student's first day of officially scheduled
2		instruction for any semester or term in which the
3		student is enrolling at the particular college or
4		campus; and
5	(2)	The adult or minor student has not been claimed as a
6		dependent for tax purposes for at least twelve months
7		next preceding the student's first day of officially
8		scheduled instruction for any semester or term in
9		which the student is enrolling at the particular
10		college or campus by the student's parents or
11		guardians who are nonresidents of the State; provided
12		that this provision shall not apply in cases where the
13		parent claiming the student as a dependent is entitled
14		to do so under a child support order or agreement
15		issued or entered into in conjunction with a divorce
16		proceeding or legal separation agreement and the other
17		parent and the student meet the criteria set forth in
18		paragraph (1) [→] ; or
19	<u>(3)</u>	The adult or minor student:
20		(A) Graduated from a high school in the State within
21		the four years immediately preceding the

1	student's first day of officially scheduled

5	(B) Will enroll in an undergraduate degree program."
6	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

### Description:

Requires the tuition residency rules for the University of Hawaii to grant the resident tuition fee for enrollment at any University of Hawaii campus to individuals who have graduated from a Hawaii high school and are enrolling in an undergraduate degree program, under certain conditions. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
