A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that pursuant to section SECTION 1. 2 302A-431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the university of Hawaii 3 reported one workers' compensation claim during the fiscal 4 biennium of 2014-2016 with a cost impact of \$1,046.36. Since 5 then, no further workers' compensation claims have been made, 6 however the university is still required by section 302A-431 to 7 submit a biennium report, whether a claim is made or not. 8 The purpose of this Act is to repeal the university's 9 reporting requirement to identify the cost impacts to the State 10 of providing workers' compensation coverage for university of 11 Hawaii students. 12 SECTION 2. Section 302A-431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended to read as follows: 14 "§302A-431 Rules[$\frac{1}{1}$ reporting]. [$\frac{1}{1}$ The board and the 15 board of regents of the University of Hawaii may adopt necessary rules under chapter 91 to administer and implement sections 16 302A-430 and 302A-431, including the adoption of safety 17 18 guidelines and safety inspection procedures of facilities where

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1	students are placed. The department and the University of
2	Hawaii shall inspect each facility annually prior to the
3	placement of students with these facilities.
4	[(b) The University of Hawaii shall submit a biennial
5	report to the governor and the legislature prior to the
6	convening of each regular session in the first year of each
7	biennium that identifies the cost impacts to the State of
8	providing workers' compensation coverage for University of
9	Hawaii students.] "
10	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken.
12	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

PURPOSE:

Repeal the reporting requirement to identify the cost impacts to the State of providing workers' compensation coverage for

University of Hawaii students.

MEANS:

Repeal section 302A-431(b), Hawaii Revised

Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION:

The purpose of this Act is to reduce the administrative burden of creating a report that is no longer necessary.

Pursuant to section 302A-431, HRS, the University shall submit a biennium report to the legislature identifying the cost impacts to the State of providing workers' compensation coverage for students. the fiscal biennium of 2014-2016, one workers' comp claim was made at a cost of \$1,046.36, but since then, no cost claims have been made; however, the University is still required to submit a report which unnecessarily takes up staff time and resources. During the 2022 regular session, the legislature amended section 302A-431 by removing the Department of Education's similar reporting requirement for the same reasons the University has cited.

Impact on the department and other agencies: The University will benefit from the reduced administrative burden of having to create and disseminate the reports.
