A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, THE OMBUDSMAN, AND THE ETHICS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of 2 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 3 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
- 4 that the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year
- 5 2023-2024 has already been exceeded by \$1,005,342,735, or 9.4
- 6 per cent. The appropriations contained in sections 2, 3, and 13
- 7 of this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
- $oldsymbol{8}$ ceiling for fiscal year 2023-2024 to be further exceeded by
- 9 \$28,572,120, or 1.0 per cent. This declaration takes into
- 10 account the additional general fund appropriations authorized
- 11 for fiscal year 2023-2024 in this Act only. The reasons for
- 12 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that:
- 13 (1) The appropriations made in this Act are necessary to

 14 serve the public interest; and
- 15 (2) The appropriations made in this Act meet the needs
 16 addressed by this Act.

Unless otherwise prescribed by law, the 4 expenses of any member of the legislature while traveling abroad 5 on official business of the legislature shall be \$145 a day as 6 authorized by the president of the senate and speaker of the 7 house of representatives. 8 SECTION 7. There is appropriated out of the general 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,556,800 or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor for the 11 following expenses: 12 The sum of \$3,406,800 for defraying the expenses of (1)13 the office of the auditor during fiscal year 2024-2025; and 14 The sum of \$150,000 during fiscal year 2024-2025 for: 15 (2) 16 Performing special studies; (A) 17 (B) Improving capabilities for planning, programming, 18 and budgeting; 19 (C) Fulfilling other special requests made of the 20 auditor by the legislature or jointly by the

1		president of the senate and the speaker of the		
2		house of representatives;		
3	(D)	Legislative studies and contractual services for		
4		those studies; and		
5	(E)	Such other purposes as may be determined by the		
6		joint action of the president of the senate and		
7		the speaker of the house of representatives.		
8	The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by			
9	the auditor.			
10	SECTION 8. There is appropriated out of the general			
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$2,800,000 or so muc			
12	thereof as may be necessary to the office of the auditor during			
13	fiscal year 2024-2025 to be deposited into the audit revolving			
14	fund established pursuant to section 23-3.6, Hawaii Revised			
15	Statutes.			
16	SECTION 9. There is appropriated out of the audit			
17	revolving fund the sum of \$6,300,000 or so much thereof as may			
18	be necessary to the office of the auditor during fiscal year			
19	2024-2025 for the office to conduct or complete its audit			
20	functions as provided by law.			
21	The sum a	opropriated shall be expended by the auditor.

- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,265,423 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary to the legislative reference bureau
- 4 for defraying the expenses of the legislative reference bureau
- 5 during fiscal year 2024-2025, including equipment relating to
- 6 computer systems programming and operations.
- 7 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 8 the legislative reference bureau.
- 9 SECTION 11. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,574,544 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the ombudsman for
- 12 defraying the expenses of the office during fiscal year
- **13** 2024-2025.
- 14 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by
- 15 the ombudsman.
- 16 SECTION 12. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,584,678 or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary to the office of the state ethics
- 19 commission for defraying the expenses of the office during
- 20 fiscal year 2024-2025.

1 The sum appropriated in this section shall be expended by

2 the state ethics commission.

3 SECTION 13. There is appropriated out of the general

4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the following sums or so much

5 thereof as may be necessary to be expended for the purpose of

6 accrued vacation payments and vacation transfer payments for any

7 employee leaving the employ of the senate, house of

8 representatives, office of the auditor, legislative reference

9 bureau, office of the ombudsman, and state ethics commission:

- 1 SECTION 14. As of the close of business on June 30, 2025,
- 2 the unexpended or unencumbered balance of any appropriation made
- 3 by this Act shall lapse into the general fund.
- 4 SECTION 15. Each section of this Act is declared to be
- 5 severable from the remainder of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 16. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
