1 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
2 Hawaii for fiscal year 2024-2025:

3 1. Kapolei Parkway, Oahu

4 Construction of crosswalks, speedbumps, and road signs  
5 on Kapolei Parkway due to its proximity to Kapolei  
6 high school and Kapolei middle school.

7 Total funding: \$2,000,000

8 SECTION 4. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of  
9 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and  
10 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined  
11 that the appropriations contained in this Act will cause the  
12 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025  
13 to be exceeded by \$ or per cent. The reasons for  
14 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the  
15 appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve the  
16 public interest and to meet the needs provided for by this Act.

17 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated for the respective  
18 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
19 department of education for the purposes of this Act.


