

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§302A- Financial literacy; curriculum; public schools.		
5	(a) The department shall develop and, beginning with the		
6	2024-2025 school year, implement a financial literacy curriculum		
7	within the social studies course of study for public school		
8	students in kindergarten through twelfth grade.		
9	(b) The financial literacy curriculum required pursuant to		
10	subsection (a) shall include but not be limited to:		
11	(1) Fundamentals of banking for personal use, including		
12	but not limited to savings and checking;		
13	(2) Principles of budgeting and personal finance;		
14	(3) Employment and understanding factors that affect net		
15	<pre>income;</pre>		
16	(4) Uses and effects of credit, including the relation of		
17	debt and interest to credit;

1	(5)	Uses and costs of loans, including student loans;
2	(6)	Types and costs of insurance;
3	<u>(7)</u>	Forms of governmental taxation;
4	(8)	Principles of investing and building wealth;
5	(9)	<pre>Identity theft and security;</pre>
6	(10)	Planning and paying for postsecondary education; and
7	(11)	Charitable giving.
8	(c)	Instruction in the financial literacy curriculum shall
9	be grade a	and age appropriate for the following grade levels:
10	(1)	Kindergarten through fifth grade;
11	(2)	Sixth grade through eighth grade; and
12	(3)	Ninth grade through twelfth grade."
