## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ATTORNEYS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that out-of-state 2 attorneys who practice in Hawaii's courts pro hac vice may be 3 unaware that they owe the State general excise tax. Unlike the general excise tax in most states, Hawaii's tax applies to both 4 gross rental income and gross service income. The legislature 5 6 believes that amending the process by which out-of-state 7 attorneys are admitted to practice law in Hawaii's courts will 8 help inform the attorneys of their state tax obligations. 9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require attorneys applying for a pro hac vice appearance in the State's 10 11 courts to provide: 12 Evidence of the applicant's and local counsel's Hawaii (1)

- 12 (1) Evidence of the applicant's and local counsel's Hawall
  13 business registrations;
- 14 (2) The applicant's and local counsel's Hawaii general
- 15 excise tax license numbers;

15	(2)	The applicant's and local counsel's Hawaii general	
16		excise tax license numbers;	
17	(3)	An affirmation that both the applicant and local	
18		counsel will pay all state income tax due for Hawaii	
19		business activities; and	
20	(4)	All other information or documentation required by the	
21		rules of the supreme court."

SECTION 3. No later than days after the effective
 date of this Act, the supreme court shall amend its rules for
 the pro hac vice appearance of counsel for court proceedings and
 arbitration proceedings in accordance with this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 7 begun before its effective date.

8 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
