#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 4, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2 2021, is amended by amending section 1 to read as follows: 3 "SECTION 1. [<del>(a)</del>] The department of health may require the department of education [shall publish a weekly] to report 4 5 on [schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated 6 individual who has tested positive for coronavirus disease 2019 7 [(COVID-19). The report shall include: 8 (1) The school's name; 9 (2) The date the COVID-19 positive test result was 10 reported to the school; and 11 (3) The date that the positively tested individual was 12 last on the school campus. 13 (b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after 14 July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website. 15 potential outbreaks or other public health emergencies and 16 related information in a manner most appropriate to public 17 health and safety, as determined by the department of health."

### Report Title:
