
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 4, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii
2 2021, is amended by amending section 1 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 1. [~~(a)~~] The department of health may require
4 the department of education [shall publish a weekly] to report
5 on [schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated
6 individual who has tested positive for] coronavirus disease 2019
7 [~~(COVID-19)~~]. The report shall include:

8 ~~(1) The school's name;~~

9 ~~(2) The date the COVID-19 positive test result was~~
10 ~~reported to the school; and~~

11 ~~(3) The date that the positively tested individual was~~
12 ~~last on the school campus.~~

13 ~~(b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after~~
14 ~~July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website.]~~

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.



Report Title:

Department of Health; Department of Education; COVID-19; Public Health Emergencies; Schools

Description:

Authorizes the Department of Health to require the Department of Education to report coronavirus disease 2019 potential outbreaks or other public health emergencies and related information in a manner most appropriate to public health and safety, as determined by the Department of Health. Repeals the requirement to publish the report on the Department of Education's website. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

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
