# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AQUACULTURE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The department of agriculture shall
2	conduct a	feasibility study to identify potential sites in the
3	State, wi	th a preference for sites on islands that are under
4	reconstruction as of the effective date of this Act, for an	
5	aguaculture park that promotes commercial aquaculture expansion.	
6	The study	shall consider factors for establishing an aquaculture
7	park at each potential site, including but not limited to the	
8	following:	
9	(1)	Plans and designs to support commercial aquaculture
10		expansion;
11	(2)	Zoning requirements, building codes, and existing
12		conditions, including any easements and property
13		disputes;
14	(3)	The current usage of neighboring property and any
15		potential environmental impacts;
16	(4)	Any required variance, permit, or approval; and
17	(5)	A projected budget and timeline for construction

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- 1 (b) The department of agriculture shall submit a report of
- 2 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 3 legislation, resulting from the feasibility study to identify
- 4 potential sites in the State for an aquacultural park to the
- 5 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 6 the regular session of 2025.
- 7 SECTION 2. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 8 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
- 9 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
- 10 appropriations contained in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023,
- 11 and this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure
- 12 ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
- 13 \$ or per cent. This current declaration takes
- 14 into account general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal
- 15 year 2024-2025 in Act 164, Regular Session of 2023, and this Act
- 16 only. The reasons for exceeding the general fund expenditure
- 17 ceiling are that:
- 18 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
- serve the public interest; and
- 20 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
- 21 addressed by this Act.

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- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
- 4 the department of agriculture to conduct a feasibility study
- 5 that identifies potential sites in the State for an aquaculture
- 6 park that promotes commercial aquaculture expansion.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

DOA; Feasibility Study; Aquaculture Park; Report; Appropriation; Expenditure Ceiling

Requires the Department of Agriculture to conduct a feasibility study to identify potential sites in the State for an aquaculture park that promotes commercial aquaculture expansion. Requires a report to the Legislature prior to the Regular Session of 2025. Makes an appropriation. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
