A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as the largest
- 2 department in the State with two hundred ninety-five schools and
- 3 forty-two thousand salaried and part-time employees, the
- 4 department of education must procure voluminous amounts of goods
- 5 and services to run its operation. However, the department's
- 6 small purchase procurement capacity is limited to under \$25,000
- 7 per twelve-month period, positioning the department as the only
- 8 state department to not receive an increase threshold of
- 9 \$100,000 for small purchase procurement.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the department of
- 11 education is mandated to provide at least thirty per cent
- 12 locally sourced foods to Hawaii's public schools by 2030.
- 13 Increasing the department's small purchase procurement capacity
- 14 for local edible produce and packaged food products will assist
- 15 the department in fulfilling its mandate to provide locally
- 16 sourced foods for the State's public schools.

3	(1)	Exempting purchases of local edible produce and
4		packaged food products less than \$100,000 from the
5		electronic procurement system requirement; and
6	(2)	Requiring no less than three written quotes for
7		purchases of local edible produce and packaged food
8		products between \$15,000 to less than \$100,000.
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
10	amended by adding to part V a new section to be appropriately	
11	designated and to read as follows:	
12	" <u>§30</u>	2A- Education local edible produce and packaged
13	food prod	ucts procurement; small purchases. Notwithstanding
14	section 103D-305(c) and any other law to the contrary,	
15	procurements of less than \$100,000 for local edible produce and	
16	packaged food products for the department shall be exempt from	
17	the requirement to conduct such procurements through an	
18	electronic system and shall only be subject to no less than	
19	three written quotes for procurements of \$15,000 to less than	
20	\$100,000."	
21	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
