BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 302A-1143, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	(1)	The department shall, within five days of receipt of a
5		military order, accept an application for school or

9		with proof of one of the following addresses for
10		purposes of school placement:
11		(A) Pending or current occupancy in a temporary on-
12		base billeting facility or other temporary
13		accommodation within the local community;
14		(B) An agreement to purchase, construct, or lease a
15		dwelling within the local community; or
16		(C) Waitlisted status or pending or current occupancy
